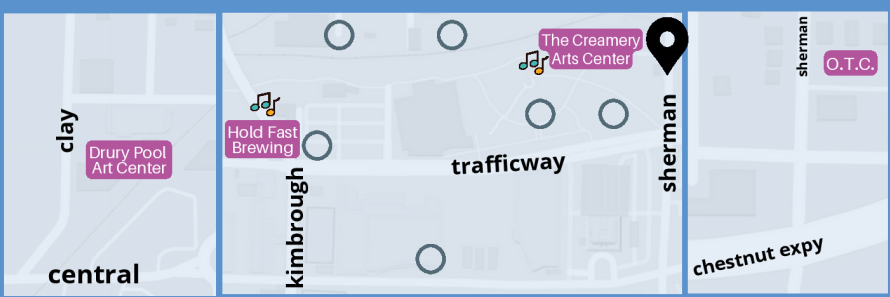

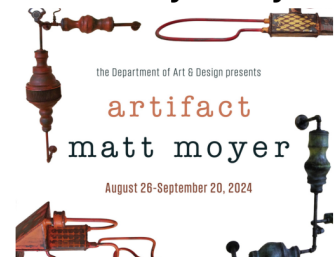
The Gillioz Theatre
